ECS Community,

I am writing to provide an update regarding the launch of Eugene Christian High School. As you may be aware, we determined not to open the high school in the fall of 2018 due to an accreditation issue. In short, we were unable to gain initial accreditation due to some policy constraints with one of our school accreditors.

I am happy to report that this issue has since been resolved and we are now able to open a Christian high school program with full 9-12 accredited status. This is a major success for our program as we'd now be able to offer an accredited high school diploma that can be accepted by any college, university or trade school. This would also serve as a potential catalyst for our middle school students to earn high school credits while successfully completing high school courses.

However, our current challenge is find the appropriate facility for the opening of the high school. Our current PreK-8 campus on Chad Drive was considered for the opening in the fall of 2018, but we believe a different site will better suit both the short and long term needs of the high school. Within the current Chad Drive campus, our PreK-8 program is utilizing most of the classroom space and continued enrollment growth is expected in 2019 and beyond.

At this time we are considering everything from an off campus lease to possibly constructing a new high school building. These options are still in negotiation and no official plans have been made.

Our high school interest list continues to increase and we're prayerful that the right facility will come available soon. We believe there is a demand for a quality Christian high school in this area and Lord willing, we will continue to pursue this opportunity. Unless we are able to secure a site in the next 30-60 days, our potential high school launch would be in the fall of 2020.
